



# BHS art students provide community mural for the Hyannis Youth and Community Center.

Under the direction of Barnstable High School art teacher Carl Lopes, twelve honor level BHS art students from the Fine Arts IV program are creating a 4foot by 24 foot mural to hang at the Hyannis Youth and Community Center (HYCC).

Each student selected an area of interest that represents activities from the Town's Recreation Department such as sailing, having fun at birthday parties and the playground, beaches/life guards, hockey and baseball. The students reviewed images from various recreation programs as well as additional research for the project. Within the imagery the mural illustrates the diversity of our community.

The mural, constructed on tempered masonite boards cut into 2ft by 4 ft panels, is currently being worked on by the students while at school. The project is expected to be completed by mid-June and brought over to the HYCC for installation.
